

**Central Iowa ARMA Chapter Meeting

Topic:

Lincoln Electric System (LES) Accounts Payable Imaging Project Using SharePoint with SAP

Bill Lang will present a case study of the LES implementation of their accounts payable imaging project using SharePoint and interface with SAP. The presentation will include a discussion of how we started this project, a review of the design, and a demonstration of the process along with lessons learned.

LES changed from a physical filing, routing, and look-up environment for accounts payable invoices to an electronic environment the fall of 2008. Invoices are scanned and stored in SharePoint with an image link to the transaction in SAP. When required, an invoice is sent electronically for payment approval instead of making a copy and sending through the internal mail. Information is exchanged nightly between SharePoint and SAP. Within SAP, a user can use a link to view the invoice image.

Bill Lang has worked for Lincoln Electric System for over 36 years with most of the time in an Information Technology role. He currently is a System Architect in the Enterprise Content Management / Business Processes department. His current focus is design and deployment of SharePoint company wide for document management, collaboration and business records management.
