Jeremy co-founded the Minneapolis chapter of the International Information Systems Forensics Association (IISFA), is the author of numerous industry-related articles, a frequent national lecturer and quoted source, and was a guest lecturer at the University of Denver, University of Iowa, William Mitchell College of Law and an adjunct professor at Metropolitan State University where he taught digital evidence analysis. He holds a B.A. in marketing and a B.S. in computer science from the University of Iowa.
